- Overall everyone at the meeting though they were improved, wording on report cards was brought up to district, as well as some people felt percentages would be better for grade 4 up
- Grade Configuration (Taking grades 7-8 out of Elementary)
 - Dr.Clark and Greely Road parents/staff are split 50-50 on Grade 7-8 moving to Comp,
 Ecole Mactavish will become 7-12, possibly in 2017, Composite High school will follow suit and be 7-12
 - Options for Grade 7-8 are more advanced and there are more of them than in an elementary school

Diploma Exams:

 Most people were in favor of changing the diploma exams from 50% as it is currently to 30%

Teacher Report: Shelley Kellington/Rhonda Blanchette:

- Rhonda would like to request 20 Hokki chairs in three sizes, approximate cost \$2000-\$3000
- Provided some information on a Life Coach that comes highly recommended for putting on parent seminars, suggested parents plus to pay form parenting sessions for the school, the life coach is available for day or evening sessions, and her seminars have a large range in topics

Principal's Report: Waleed Najmeddine:

1. Growth Plan

Annual Education Results Report/School Education Plan (AERR/SEP) 2015-17 was
presented to FMPSD Board of Trustees on December 1, and was received very well.
Thanks to all staff members and parents who contributed to development of the plan.
Accountability Pillar results continue to be very strong, and have been posted in the school foyer.

2. Lockdown drill

- Second lockdown drill of 2014-15 carried out on January 8. Students and staff were only notified in advance of the date, not the exact time. All doors were found to be locked and students extremely quiet. Very impressive performance. For the next drill there will be no advance warning.

3. APPLE Schools

 Due to budget constraints, APPLE Schools is no longer able to provide free apples to any Fort McMurray schools effective January 2015. Some parents, however, have already donated about one-half of the funds required to continue providing apples for the remainder of the school year. This issue will be brought to our next staff meeting to develop a long-term plan going forward into 2015-16

4. "Power Skating" program

- In collaboration with our Solange Maher, Keyano Huskies hockey team, and Frank Lacroix Arena, we have put together a weekly skating program for Beacon Hill Students. This program will be available to up to 40 students and will run every Tuesday afternoon from 2:30 3:30 p.m. from Feb. 3 Mar. 24. There is no charge to register, and skates/helmets will be provided as needed. Students interested must get parent permission and teacher approval to ensure academics are not affected. Good behaviour record is also a factor. Notice and permission forms to be sent the week of Jan. 26.
- Parents Plus committee are asked to consider possibility of covering cost of ice time @
 \$100 per week.
