Principal's Report: Waleed Najmeddine

- **Staff Update**: Mrs. Payne back to work after leave, starts full time hours next week, Ms.Yazdani will be replacing Ms.Haywood as EA in ECDP and Grade 1, Deanna Puga due back in February
- **FNMI**: Mr.Pollard is the schools liaison to the FNMI. He will be presenting to staff the awareness and understanding of residential schools/Truth and Reconciling implementation plan, and will be training them so that the teachers can then teach their students. Grades K-6 Implementation of Project of Heart, and Grade 7-12 continuing implementation of 100 years.

 active, each day a student reminds the school by announcement and gives an activity for
 everyone to try,
 - Winter walk is on Feb 5th at 1:30pm, Mr.Pollard is working on getting mascots and local celebrities to join us
 - St.Marthas madness tournament between districts girls grade 5/6 basketball
